- We aim to capitalize on behavioral biases that may cause the market to over-react to old, negative information (e.g., panic) or under-react to new, positive information (e.g., not pay attention).
- We look for companies with significant insider buying or stock repurchases (over-reaction), and large earnings surprises (under-reaction).

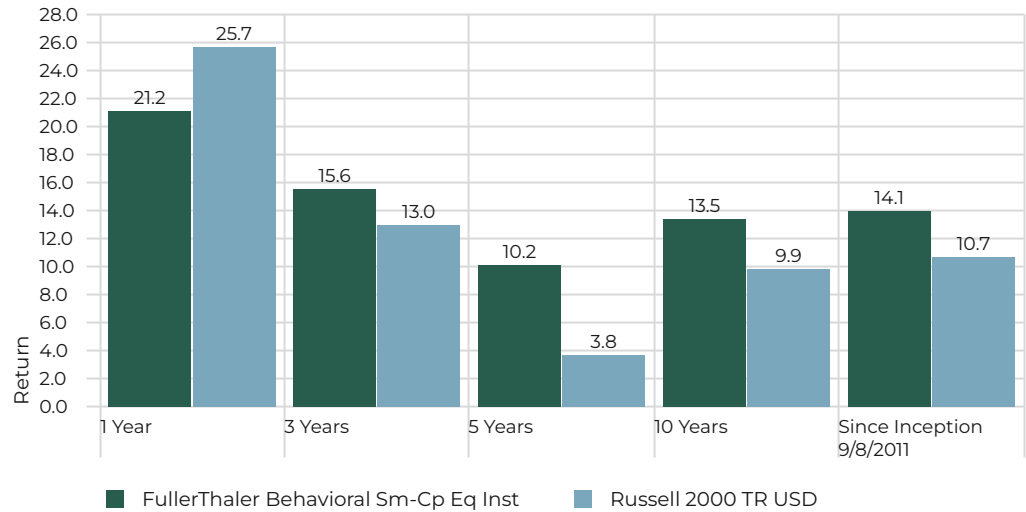

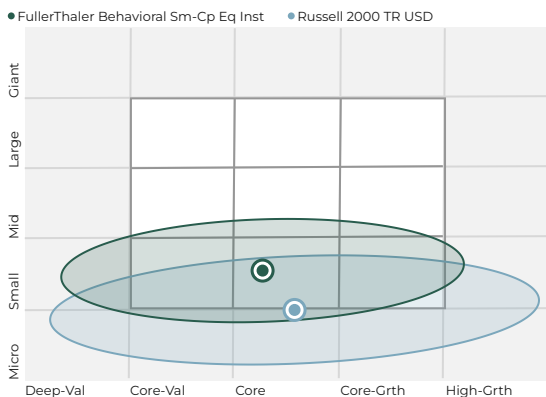

The prospectus expense ratios are 1.07% for FTHAX, 1.64% for FTYCX, 1.05% for FTHNX, 0.76% for FTHSX and 0.64% for FTHFX. The Fund has used the Russell 2000® as its benchmark since October 23, 2015. The Russell 2000® is an index of small-cap US stocks, approximately the 1001st to 3000th largest US stocks as calculated by Russell. Unless otherwise noted, index returns reflect the reinvestment of income dividends and capital gains, if any, but do not reflect fees, brokerage commissions or other expenses of investing. It is not possible to invest directly in the index. Fund returns reflect the reinvestment of any dividend and interest income. The Russell Index related marks are owned by FTSE Russell.

The Morningstar Rating for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for managed products (including mutual funds, variable annuity and variable life subaccounts, exchange-traded funds, closed-end funds, and separate accounts) with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The Morningstar Rating does not include any adjustment for sales loads. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star. The Overall Morningstar Rating for a managed product is derived from a weighted average of the performance figures associated with its three-, five-, and 10-year (if applicable) Morningstar Rating metrics. The weights are: 100% three-year rating for 36-59 months of total returns, 60% five-year rating/40% three-year rating for 60-119 months of total returns, and 50% 10-year rating/30% five-year rating/20% three-year rating for 120 or more months of total returns. While the 10-year overall star rating formula seems to give the most weight to the 10-year period, the most recent three-year period actually has the greatest impact because it is included in all three rating periods. The rating is for the Institutional Share Class (FTHSX) only. Different share classes may have different ratings. Morningstar Category/Morningstar Category % Rank Investments are placed into Morningstar categories based on their compositions and portfolio statistics so that investors can make meaningful comparisons. Morningstar Category % Rank is a fund's total-return percentile rank relative to all funds in the same category. The highest (or most favorable) percentile rank is one and the lowest (or least favorable) percentile rank is 100. The Category % Rank complements the Morningstar Rating, especially for funds in smaller categories because these funds may have received a 3-star rating but could be in the top half of their category performance.
